The Committee to whom was referred to much of the Constitution as relates to the Militia, Having Consideration of the duty afrequed them, respectly respectfully. Inbuilt the following report to the Consideration of the Convention.

Lee 1, The Militia of this State Shall Consist of star all free able bodied white male Citizens, residents of this same between the ages of eighteen and forty five years, except such persons as now are or hereafter may be exempted by the laws of the United States or of this State.

Lee. I. May possen whose religious tenets or Conscientions surplus forbid them to Carry arms, that not be Computed to do so in time of fease, but thate pay an equivalent for personal service.

Lee B The Governor that appoint the Adjutant Seneral and his other staff officers The Majors Jeneral, Bugadiers Jeneral, Colonels, Lieutenant Colonels, Majors, Captains, and Subaltums, Shall be elected by the persons subject to military duty in their respective districts.
