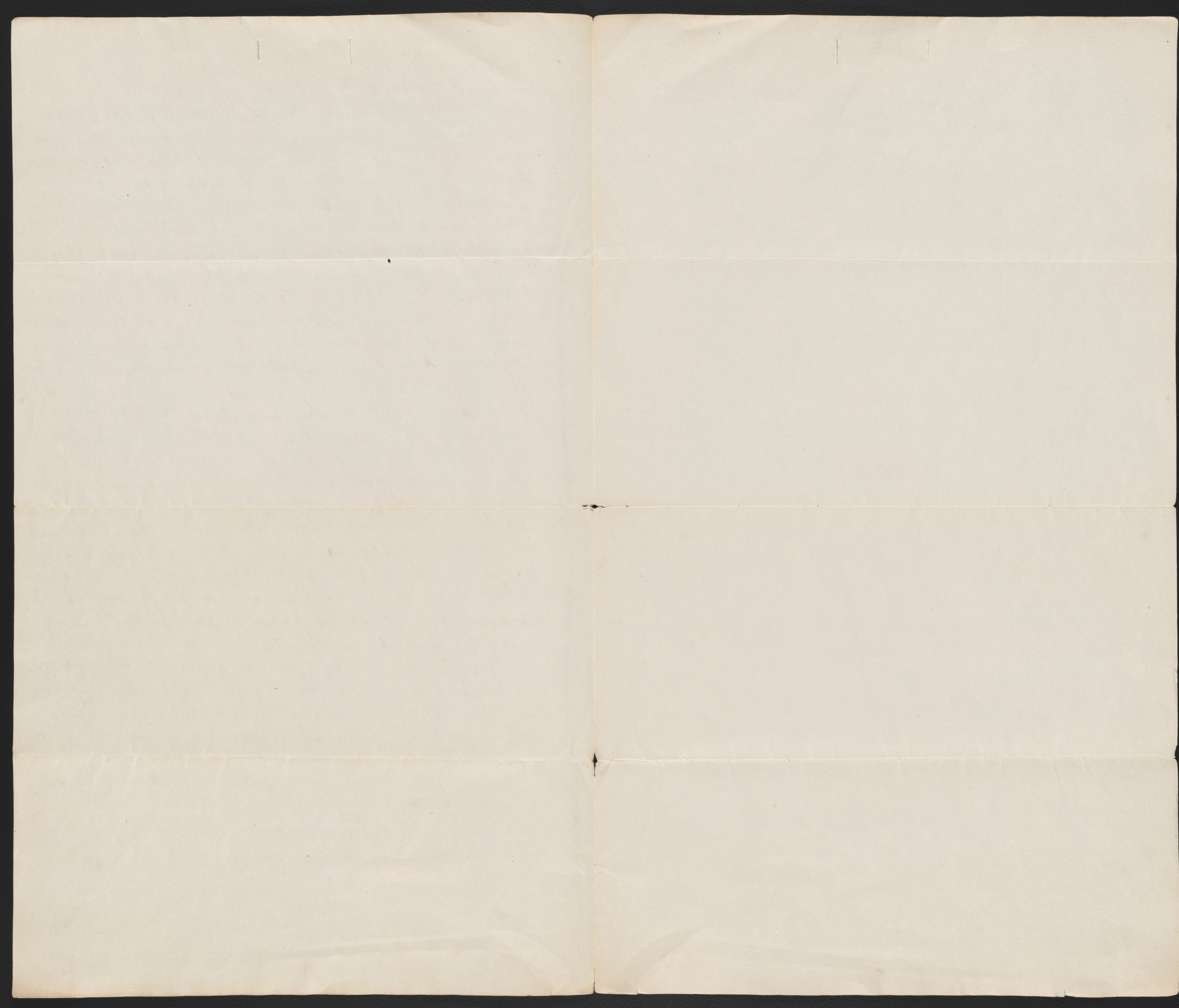

The Territory of Oregon to all to whom these
presents shall come greeting. Know ye that where
as Jason Lee late of the county of Champlain and
Territory of Oregon died on or about the 12th day
of March A.D. 1845, as it is said, after having
duly made and published his last will and tes-
tament, a copy whereof is herewith annexed,
leaving at the time of his death property in this
Territory which may be lost, destroyed or dimin-
ished in value if speedy care be not taken of the
same; and inasmuch as it appears that Alvin
F. Waller has been appointed executor in and by
the said last will and testament to execute
the same, and to the end that the said prop-
erty may be preserved for those who shall
appear to have a legal right or interest
therein, and that said ^{will} may be executed ac-
cording to the request of the said testator, we
do hereby authorize him, the said Alvin F. Waller,
as such executor, to collect and secure all and
singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits
which were of the said Jason Lee at the time of his
decease in whose soever hands or possession the same
may be found in this Territory and well and truly
to fulfil and perform all such duties as may
be enjoined upon him by the said will, so far
as there shall be property and the law charge
him, and in general to do and perform all oth-
er acts which now are or hereafter may be re-
quired of him by law. Witness W. H. Willson
