Page, a Notary Public, duly commissioned and qualified, dwelling in said City, did present the original promissory note, to "James Burk" the indorsee for payment, which was refused, no excuse being given, and I could not present the same to the drawer thereof, because that he is, and is, out of this State, and in British Columbia. —
