ORHI 94776

No County of this State shall be allowed to apply its annual apportionment of the ~~XXXXXX~~ proceeds of the school fund, for the school purposes, unless there shall have been raised in the County, <sup>apart from the general school tax which may be made by law</sup> by taxation or otherwise, an amount of school money, equal to one half of said apportionment.

No division of the common school fund, or of any annual apportionment, shall ever be made at the instance of, or for the use and benefit of, any religious sect or persuasion.

No distinction in the selection of incumbents for office in any department of the common school system, or in the eligibility of instructors, or in the privileges of patrons and pupils shall ever be made on account of religious opinion, provided such religious opinions be not against the policies, peace, and dignity of the State.

No sectarian influence in behalf of or against any religious tenet or persuasion shall be inculcated in <sup>any</sup> common school in this State.

Sec 7<sup>th</sup>

The Legislature shall provide by law for the election of a state superintendent of public instruction, and prescribe his duties and compensation, and for the election of officers to fill such other offices as may be made by law in the respective counties and school districts.

Sec 8

The Governor of this State shall be ~~ex-officio~~ <sup>ex-officio</sup> State Commissioner of ~~the~~ Common Schools and of the common school fund, and shall report to the Legislature thereon, and recommend measures for the management of the same.
