

## Article XIV

### Seat of Government

Sec 1 The Legislative Assembly shall not have power to establish a permanent seat of Government for this State. But at the first regular session after the adoption of this Constitution the Legislative Assembly shall provide by law for the submission to the electors, of this State at the next general election thereafter, the matter of the selection of a place for a permanent seat of government, and no place shall ever be the seat of government under such law, which shall not receive a majority of all the votes cast on the matter of such selection

Sec 2 No tax shall be laid or money of the State expended or debt contracted for the erection of a State House prior to the year eighteen hundred and fifty five



Sec 8 The Seat of Government when  
established as provided in Section  
one, shall not be removed for  
the term of twenty years from the  
time of such establishment; nor in  
any other manner than as provided  
in the first section of this article  
provided that all Public institutions  
of the State hereafter provided for  
by the Legislative Assembly  
shall be located at the Seat  
of Government.



Article <sup>XIV</sup>

Sec 1 The Legislative Assembly shall not have power to establish a permanent Seat of Government for the State —

But after the term of years from the adoption of this Constitution the Legislative Assembly may provide by law for the submission to the Electors, of this State, the matter of the selection of a place for a permanent Seat of Government and no place shall ever be the Seat of Government under such law, which shall not receive a Majority of all the votes cast on the matter of such selection

Sec 2 No tax shall be levied on money of the State expended for the erection a State House prior to the year ~~eighteen~~ hundred and

Sec 3<sup>d</sup> The Seat of Government when established as provided in Section one, shall not be removed for the term of years from the time of first establishment nor in any other manner than as provided ~~in Section one~~ in the first Section of this Article
