Mr. W. L. Finley, Chairman,

Advisory Committee on Wildlife
I have your letter of October 21st, covering the
Rt. resolution passed by the Oregon State Council of
Jenn the Isaac Walton League of America.

Dear Our Committee on Wildlife had this matter up at
one of our meetings sometime ago, and we are very
much in favor of the acquisition of Wapato Lake
and also the creation of a refuge for ducks on J.
Buck, the upper Long Tom. We are very much in need of
two or three refuges for ducks in the Willamette
Valley. copy of resolution passed at the seventh annual con-
vention of the Isaac Walton League, July 19-21, 1935.

I am not familiar with the plans for the Willamette
Valley project which has been under consideration,
but if this goes through, it may be that some pro-
vision can be made regarding a refuge on the Long
Tom. This should be embraced in the plans. I am also enclosing copy of my
letter to Wapato Lake, this will require funds for pur-
chasing the area and these might be supplied by the
United States Biological Survey from money collected
on the Duck Stamp Tax. I shall take this matter up
direct with Mr. Darling, Chief of the Biological Sur-
vey.

Personally, I do not know of any agency other than the
U. S. My suggestion is that at the next meeting of the
State Planning Board it would help if a resolution
that is passed covering Wapato Lake and sent to Mr. Isaac
Walton Darling might be put into effect if you agree that they are
necessary and desirable.

The State Planning Board at meeting October 18th considered a letter dated October 1, 1935 addressed to Mr. C. J. Buck, vice-chairman of the Board, from Mr. Francis Lambert, Secretary of the Oregon Council of the Isaac Walton League of America, together with copy of resolution passed at the seventh annual convention of the Isaac Walton League, July 19-21, 1935.

Before taking any action on this matter the Board requested me to transmit copy of Mr. Lambert's letter and the resolution to you for investigation and report by you and Advisory Committee on Wild Life. Accordingly, copy of Mr. Lambert's letter and the resolution are enclosed. I am also enclosing copy of my letter of today to Mr. Francis Lambert.
