OUTDOOR RECREATION COMMITTEE MEETING

April 5, 1932

Committee discussed proposed resolution brought to its attention by Mr. W. L. Finley which would exclude domestic sheep from the Wallowa Mountain area and keep it as a wild game preserve and recreational section. Mr. Horton told the committee that game in this area had been on the increase in spite of the fact that sheep have used this territory for grazing and that in his opinion it would be necessary to make an adjustment keeping certain sections open for grazing rather than closing the whole area entirely - which would be disastrous to the owners of large herds. It was decided to lay the matter on the table until Mr. Finley's return.

Committee suggested that Mr. Say communicate with Mr. Laton of Clarkston, Washington and ascertain in what way the chamber could co-operate with that territory in celebrating the completion and dedication of the Blue Mountain road between Clarkston and Enterprise.
