

PIN-TAIL, SPRIG OR LONG-NECK DUCK.

Oregon duck hunters, well know the sprig or pin-tail duck, sometimes called "long-neck." Large numbers of this species are annually shot during the duck season. They breed and nest in the swamps and lake areas up and down the Pacific coast, and, like other migratory water fowl, they are declared to be suffering heavy losses from the reduction of breeding areas.
